REACH ACT

- Act 26 of 2021, known as the Reinforcing College Education on America's Constitutional Heritage Act (REACH Act), requires undergraduate students of South Carolina public institutions of higher learning to complete a three-credit course in which students, at a minimum, read in their entirety the following Founding Documents:
 - The United States Constitution
 - The Declaration of Independence
 - The Emancipation Proclamation
 - Five (5) Federalist Papers
 - One or more documents foundational to the African American Struggle.



REACH ACT COMPLIANCE

- The General Assembly tasked the Commission on Higher Education (CHE) with ensuring the public institutions comply with REACH Act provisions and to collect information necessary from public institutions to ensure compliance.
 - CHE collects and reviews syllabi for REACH Act courses taught annually.



REACH ACT COMPLIANCE

- In Fall 2023, CHE clarified the compliance process for transfer students:
 - Beginning in Fall 2024, if an incoming transfer student has a transfer course equivalent to one of USC's REACH Act (FND) courses, the credit hours will be applicable toward their total hours, however, it will not count towards REACH Act compliance unless the transfer in course has been approved by CHE as REACH Act compliant. See [list](#) of CHE approved courses.
 - Additionally, beginning in Fall 2024 students should not be approved to take an FND course as a transient student at a non-USC institution, unless that course is a CHE-approved REACH Act course offered at another SC institution.



REACH ACT COMPLIANCE FOR TRANSFER STUDENTS

- Students with an equivalent, but not CHE-approved REACH Act course will be asked to complete an online module that covers the required founding documents.
 - Only transfer students with an equivalent transfer course will be eligible to take this module.
 - Students without an equivalent transfer course will still be expected to complete a 3-hour FND course at USC.
