1. Total tuition figures above include the cumulative total for all tuition and fees which will be assessed based on the student's progression standing within the professional program, residency status, and full-time versus part-time enrollment.
2. Fees assessed by the college, **\$250 per semester**, will be used to support the college's efforts to:
 - Provide requirements for experiential learning (ex: name badge, learning program management systems).
 - Provide electronic drug information resources, certification programs, ExamSoft access for electronic testing, and self-assessment platforms.
 - Provide printing for students within the COP building.
 - Provide required background checks while admitted (does not include pre-matriculation required screenings).
 - Provide a comprehensive NAPLEX (national licensure exam) review program and the Pre-NAPLEX assessment for students nearing graduation.
2. The above fees also include the **USC Technology Fee** as appropriate, **\$200 per semester** or pro-rated for per credit hour tuition.
3. The above fees also include the **USC Athletics Auxiliary Fee** as appropriate, **\$150 per semester** or pro-rated for per credit hour tuition.
4. All professional program students retaking a course during the summer terms are required to pay the per credit hour rate for the repeated course and the regular summer program fee. Students who must schedule an additional IPPE or APPE due to a deficiency in the previous practice experience will be billed the appropriate per hour tuition for this extra course.
5. All professional program students will be assessed an additional per credit hour charge for course hours outside the Doctor of Pharmacy program.
